Thousands of hospitality business and their employees struggle to cope with the ongoing cost of living crisis. The rising costs of accommodation, food and fuel are placing more hospitality families in danger of homelessness, and many businesses are at risk of failure, putting thousands of jobs in jeopardy.

Hospitality Action has consistently innovated to deliver financial and mental health support alongside advice and signposting to people facing poverty, homelessness, and deteriorating mental health.

In 2025, Hospitality Action awarded over £1.05 million in financial grants, the highest annual figure since the pandemic. In addition, over £500,000 in unclaimed benefits was unlocked, and hundreds of cases were referred to specialist housing advocacy and debt restructuring services.
